Presenting best practices related to PISA and Reading Literacy to CBSE at their Head office at Delhi

Another event of interest this summer was my visit to the CBSE on July 26th, along with Mr. Sanjeev Jolly, Principal/CEO of Our Own Boys Dubai, and UAE Chapter Convener for CBSE. We were invited by CBSE to explain the best practices followed at our schools to raise attainment and standards, especially as India prepares to take up the PISA assessments in 2021. The presentation was attended by Mrs. Anita Karwal, IAS, Chairperson CBSE along with eminent top brass from CBSE. She was highly impressed to hear from me about the systems and processes particularly at NMS.



Approval received from CBSE to offer **Artificial Intelligence** as 6th optional subject in Grade 9, at NMS

From the CBSE circular:

Artificial Intelligence (AI) is being widely recognized to be the power that will fuel the future global digital economy. Al in the past few years has gained geostrategic importance and a large number of countries are striving hard to stay ahead with their policy initiatives to get their country ready. India's own AI Strategy identifies AI as an opportunity & solution provider for inclusive economic growth and social development. The report also identifies the importance of skills-based education (as opposed to knowledge intensive education), and the value of project related work in order to "effectively harness the potential of AI in a sustainable manner" and to make India's next generation to be 'AI ready'.

Al will complement our existing GENIUS HOUR program in Grade 9, through a certified approach. More details will be provided when we reopen in September to Grade 9 families, or students who seek this as an alternative subject apart from the existing 5 subjects.

NMS has applied to KHDA to offer the IGCSE Program, as a parallel curriculum in Grade 9/Year 10, starting September 2020

It might seem of interest to some families at NMS, that we are in the process of seeking KHDA approval to offer the IGCSE programme, starting Grade 9 / Year 10 as a parallel pathway along with CBSE. This is yet at the nascent stage at KHDA and we will update parents of the outcomes . We hope to leverage on the already enriched curriculum that we offer at NMS and diversify the programme of study in the secondary school. We have been working on this proposal very strategically and hope to receive KHDA's approval in due course. If received, NMS will offer in addition to the already offered CBSE curriculum, the IGCSE programme as well, starting Grade 9/Year 10, from September 2020.
